Statement on the Use of Artificial Intelligence (AI)

in teaching and training offered by PD Dr. habil. Alexander Klimovich

When you join a course I offer, you have the right to receive the full benefit of my expertise, experience, and dedicated effort.

- I do not use Al tools to design the course, generate its content, prepare materials, create assignments, evaluate or grade your work, or provide feedback. Everything you receive from me reflects my own knowledge, judgment, and time.
- If I use AI tools for specific research or teaching purposes (for example, the analysis of biological sequences), this will be clearly disclosed (e.g., flagged in the corresponding slides).
- I may use basic AI functions implemented in text editors for spelling and grammar correction, or text compression, but the content is created by me.
- In some classes, we may use AI tools in the class, for educational purposes. In these cases, I will explain the value of such exercises, outline limitations, and set clear boundaries for the use of AI tools in them.

Thus, your training is the product of my professional expertise and commitment.

I expect the same approach from you. Unless I explicitly assign working with AI, the materials you submit (*e.g.*, protocols, reports) should be your own original work, reflecting your knowledge, skills, and effort.

- You may not use Al tools to generate or complete coursework unless I specifically instruct you.
- You may use AI tools for minor support (spelling and grammar polishing, text compression), but not for producing new content. I expect receiving authentic, original work from you.
- I will not be running any checks for AI use; instead, I trust in your academic integrity. Respecting this policy is part of your responsibility as a student.

I am deeply convinced that this approach ensures fairness, preserves the value of your academic development, and instills the values of academic honesty. I appreciate your cooperation.
